A daily hot, nutritious meal is offered by the Lucas County Senior Nutrition Program through the Area Office on Aging, and is funded by the Older Americans Act, the Ohio Department on Aging, the Ohio Department of Agriculture, local funds and donations. The senior participants are asked to give a donation for each meal, an amount is suggested by the Lucas County Senior Nutrition Program.

#### Services

Senior Centers, Inc. offers a comprehensive outreach program which seeks to help a senior participant find a solution to a particular need or problem. The main goal of the outreach program is to find the best program or service to meet the need of the individual, to help maintain the individual's independence in the community. Services include help with housekeeping, running errands, solving transportation problems and help with various housing issues. Our Outreach Coordinator will also help with insurance forms, referrals for eligibility to programs such as Medicaid, SSI, food stamps, Home Energy Assistance Program, other utility programs and applying for a Golden Buckeye card.

In 1994, the senior center purchased a van for transportation through the Ohio Department of Transportation. The van is available to transport seniors to and from the senior center for anyone living within the senior center boundaries. A weekly grocery shopping trip is also planned. A donation is encouraged for all rides.

Transportation Services for Seniors is a program for Lucas County senior citizens. Registered seniors use this transportation service for trips to the doctor. A reservation is required 48 hours in advance.

Senior Centers, Inc. bonded employees can provide light housekeeping services in a senior citizen's home. An assessment is conducted prior to starting the service to determine the needs of the client. An hourly fee is charged based on a sliding fee scale.

The Foster Grandparent Program provides a wonderful volunteer opportunity for low-income, senior citizens. The senior citizen is trained and placed in a community agency to work with special needs children. All volunteers work 20 hours per week and receive an hourly volunteer stipend and a daily travel and meal allowance.

The most important aspect of Senior Centers, Inc. is the opportunity to socialize, meet new friends and meet with old friends. The socialization offered at the center is often the reason why a senior citizen attends the center. Activities at the center can give an individual a reason to get up in the morning, while motivating the individual to look and feel their best. Senior Centers, Inc. aims to give the senior citizen who participates an opportunity to serve and to learn, to seek independence, dignity and companionship.

1. State Halfway House for Adult Males - The program assists and facilitates a successful transition of the ex-offender back into our local community. These clients are required to obtain and maintain employment during their residence in our facility. Additionally, they are encouraged to re-build family relationships and attend community living skills classes. Each client participates in both group, chemical dependency, and individual counseling sessions. Clients are required to turn in their paychecks. The VOA bookkeeper makes payments for child support and court restitution when applicable.

2. Volunteer Opportunities - The VOA is happy to work with individual volunteers or groups of volunteers, ie Sunday School classes, college fraternities, corporate groups, etc. We also receive volunteers from the Lucas County Adult Probation Department and the Toledo Municipal Court Division of Community Services. Volunteers participating in this program are able to work off community service hours as an alternative to paying court fines. We also accept volunteers from the Lucas County Department of Job & Family Services. If you interested in volunteering your services, please contact our Development Office.

3. Enterprise Program - The VOA solicits donations of real estate, automobiles, boats, etc. Cars and boats are auctioned each month at 1127 Champlain St. We also provide vehicles for needy individuals who have been referred for consideration by their church minister. Donors, who itemize, are eligible for a tax deduction at fair market value. Donations are fast and easy. Revenue raised from this program offers start-up assistance for new programs. We are also unable to use this non-restricted funding for capital improvements and for other items not covered by our funding sources.

4. Christmas Basket Program/Fund Raising - The VOA has been giving our Christmas food baskets since the early 1900's. For a number of years, VOA worked with the Old Newsboys to distribute baskets. In 1988, we began distributing baskets on our own. We rely

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on donations from the community, corporations, and the manpower of many dedicated volunteers to distribute 1,000 food baskets each Christmas.

5. I Remember Mama - The VOA remembers lonely, elderly women on Mother's Day by hosting our annual "I Remember Mama Dinner." These ladies are treated to a special dinner at a local Toledo restaurant. Corsages, Mother's Day gifts and cards are provided to each of our guests. The VOA solicits \$25 sponsors for each dinner.

6. Basket of Joy - The VOA solicits low-income senior citizens in the north Toledo neighborhood and provides a fruit basket for them.
